Press Release August 15, 2011

Mike Vezzetti, CUSD #2 Investment Advisor with Vezzetti Capital Management LLC was present at last night's board meeting to provide an annual investment report for CUSD #2. He reported for the fiscal year end 6/30/2011, Unit #2's account had an investment gain of \$66,172 (on an accrual basis). Vezzetti stated interest rates have been historically low for a period much longer than most have forecasted. Interest rates will likely stay low for longer, making fiscal 2011/2012 another year of very low income earnings.

Mr. Rardin represented CUTEA and noted appreciation for smooth contract negotiations for the newly executed 2011-2014 agreement. He also noted faculty members are looking forward to the excitement with the 1st day of school approaching.

Four drawings were presented for the prospective new RHS Concession Stand. The Board expressed support for the project including efforts to raise funds. The Board will evaluate a financial commitment to the project later in the budget year.

RHS teacher Elaine Harder presented the board with a handout of "*School Board Guide to Improving Adolescent Literacy*". She reported there were 8 strategies for School Board Members to review in the handout. Harder then invited board members to attend the next Literacy meeting in the RHS conference room on September 8th at 3:05pm.

Principal Hickey thanked the board on behalf of the RHS faculty for allowing 2 extra SIP days and reported RHS plans to focus on literacy with this "extra" school improvement time.
